Superintendent's Message

The Herman-Norcross Community School District will start the 2021-2022 school year in an **"In-Person"** learning model. This means that we will be in school starting September 7, 2021, full time with normal school hours followed.

Due to our small class sizes and good personal hygiene practices, it is felt that this will work best for our district's students and staff.

Two main points from the **Safe Learning Plan**:

A school district learning model will be based on the current COVID-19 infection rate in their county.

Regardless of the learning model, school districts are required to offer distance learning to families who may be medically vulnerable or otherwise unable or uncomfortable about returning to school.

- Face covering will be optional as we start our school year, but will not be required.
- We will continue to practice social distancing at the current recommendation of 3'.
- We will encourage students and staff who are not feeling well to stay home.

It is the goal of the district to keep all students, faculty and staff safe. In these uncertain and changing times that we are now faced with, our plan will stay fluid, meaning that if needed, we will be able to switch to a different learning model and continue to educate our students.
